

In late July, the Pharmacy Guild of Australia held their annual Student Summit. The student summit delved into the opportunities available in ownership and community. It was also a great way to show students the exciting expanding roles of a pharmacist in a community pharmacy setting and how it's such an exciting time to be a young pharmacist entering the profession. Also, the myth-busting session was a great chance for students to ask any questions that they might not have had the opportunity to previously. We also cant forget the exciting move towards full scope of practice with things like vaccination and pharmacist prescribing.

NAPSA renewed their Memorandum of Understanding with Pharmaceutical Society of Australia at the end of July. PSA provides students free and easy-access to industry-related professional updates, exclusive resources, and information regarding events and activities related to the continued professional development within pharmacy. The partnership between NAPSA and PSA is pivotal in having Australia's only governmentrecognised peak body representing pharmacists, supporting NAPSA's views and giving our students a national voice. NAPSA has also renewed their Memorandum of Understanding with the Pharmacy Guild of Australia at the beginning of September.

The Guild aims to equip students and early career pharmacists with the pathways, skills, tools and professional networks needed to be leaders in the primary health care system and owners of community pharmacies. The annual NAPSA Congress is the premier education and networking event for pharmacy students in Australia and New Zealand. Each year, a different branch hosts the conference, attracting up to 400 student delegates. Current students across all year levels are welcome to apply but applicants must be a student in the 2022 academic year.





We're here for you



Where will a career in community pharmacy take you?

Studying pharmacy?

Pharmacy is a four year degree in Australia. You'll learn all about anatomy, medicines, how chemicals interact and how illnesses are treated.

Your Intern Year

After graduating and receiving provisional registration, pharmacists undertake a 48 week long internship in a pharmacy setting, supervised by a senior pharmacist (a "Preceptor").

This year introduces you to what it's like working in a pharmacy and is a great opportunity to get to know your community.

Registered Pharmacist

After you pass your registration exams, you become a **Registered Pharmacist.**

Pharmacists undertake dispensing operations, professional services and/or clinical activities as defined for a particular workplace.

Pharmacists work independently or in a team and is accountable and are responsible for their individual actions and any advice they provide.

Pharmacist may be required to supervise interns and pharmacy assistants.

Pharmacist in Charge

A **Pharmacist in Charge** assumes responsibility for the day-to-day operations of a community pharmacy including supervision of staff, accountability and functions within the workplace.

Pharmacists at this level may be responsible for undertaking a specialist function within the community pharmacy.

Pharmacist at this level will be able to demonstrate highlevel knowledge, skills, experience and provide dispensing, professional services and clinical leadership within the workplace including clinical practice supervision.

Pharmacy Manager

Pharmacy Managers are responsible and accountable to the community pharmacy owner for all management and operational aspects of the workplace.

A Pharmacy Manager is a very experienced pharmacist with advanced level skills and knowledge of community pharmacy operations including dispensing and retail operations, professional services, clinical activities and staff/business management.

Owner

After working in pharmacy for a time, many pharmacists decide to take the next step and purchase a community pharmacy of their own.

That's where the Pharmacy Guild of Australia comes in - we look after the interests of community pharmacy owners so that they can do what they do best - provide better health outcomes for all Australians.
